 (iii) To have served as a judge or procurator for at least eight years;  
 (iv) To have been engaged in legal research or legal education, possessing a senior professional title;  
 (v) To have acquired the knowledge of law, been engaged in the professional work in the field of law, economy and trade, maritime, science and technology, etc., possessing a senior professional title or having an equivalent professional level.
